ANTIQUE & CLASSIC TRACTOR PULL RULES

1. Drivers under 16 years of age must have parents or guardians written consent.
2. Driver must be firmly seated at all times, no bouncing permitted, drivers must have at least one hand on steering wheel.
3. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times. All tractors may pull in any gear. 4 miles per hour. No torque shifting.
4. Tractors 1957 and older may pull. Serial number must be in proper place and be easily read. Tractors must have stock block. Any tractor that has a serial number or parts to make a newer tractor appear legal will be disqualified. NO turbo chargers allowed.
5. Tractors must be two wheel drive. NO duals.
6. Minimum drawbar length 18 inches from center of rear axle to point of hook measured horizontally. Drawbar to be stationary in all directions. Maximum height 20 inches from top of hitching point parallel to ground.
7. No Nitro, alcohol or Nitrous Oxide allowed.
8. 10% over factory R.P.M. An R.P.M. gauge will be available.
9. All weights must be safely secured to tractor. Front weights can go no more than 11 feet from center of rear axle. If anything falls off tractor, weights or parts, while hooked to sled – the tractor will be disqualified.
10. All tractors allowed up to 18.4-38 tires maximum. Cut or ground tires are permitted. Pressed steel wheels are permitted. Rim width not to exceed tire width. Must have tip over bars.
11. Protests are to be made before winners are announced.
12. Tractors must stop immediately upon red flag signal from judge or be disqualified. Tractors stopped for out of bounds will be measured there.
13. First puller in each class is entitled to a repull, but must take second measurement and repull in third position.
14. No radial tires allowed.
15. One tractor may pull one class and add weight up to next class.
16. Classes: 3500, 4,000, 4,000 Open, 4500, 4500 open, 5000, 5500, 5500 open, 6000, 6500, 6500 open, 7500, 8500.
17. Class winners may be reweighed. Scales on grounds.
18. NO riders on tractors.
19. NO ONE allowed on track except officials and puller.
20. JUDGES DECISION FINAL!
21. Open Class 10 MPH

1. Tractors 1957 and older.
2. Factory stock appearance.
3. Draw bar / 18" high.
4. Hang on weights may be used. Nothing past further most point of tractor.
5. 3 - MPH.
6. No cut tires. No radial tires.
7. Tractors may pull in one class and weight up to next class.
8. 3500 - 4000 - 4500 13.6 x 38 max tires.
5000 - 5500 - 6000 - 6500
 { Row Crop 15.5 x 38 } Tire
 { Standard 18.4 x 34 } Max.
9. A front height device will be used.
10. Driver under 16 must have written consent of parent.

All golf carts, gators, mules, ect. must be registered at the fairgrounds and show proof of insurance. Drivers must be 16 years of age or older. There is a 5 mph speed limit on the fair grounds.
